Children in grades 2 and above are asked to stay in worship with their families and friends. Class will be provided for younger students.

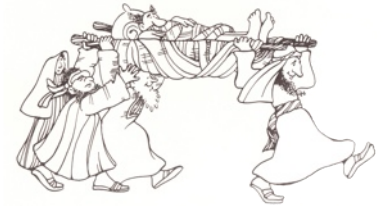
